Obtaining Internet access through CPTAV's Netcomm Wireless Firewall Router in Statewide Resource Centre meeting rooms

Important!

Before making any changes to your network settings, please note the current settings so that you can restore them at the end of this session

If your computer has a wireless adapter

Turn on your wireless networking adapter. View wireless networks. The wireless access point is called **CPTAV**. The connection is not encrypted. No password is required. You may need to change your network settings for TCP-IP. For this connection select **Obtain IP address automatically**, and **Obtain DNS server address automatically**

If your computer does not have a wireless card, but does have a PC slot on the side or back of the computer

Insert the supplied CD-ROM. When the splash screen opens, click on **Install A111 Card Adapter Utilities/Driver**

Follow the prompts and once installation is complete restart your computer.

While the computer is restarting, insert the wireless adapter card into an available PC slot. Your computer will automatically detect that adapter and load the correct drivers. If your computer is using Windows XP, a Wireless Option Window will appear. Select **"Only use the Diamond Digital Utilities..."** and click OK.

Double-click on the A111 Control Center icon, located on the desktop, or in the toolbar. This will open the Wireless LAN settings utility. Search for available networks by clicking on the **Survey** option. Select **CPTAV** from the list of networks and click on **Connect**.

If you have borrowed a wireless adapter card, please remember to return it at the end of the session.

If you are using a computer with an ethernet card

Obtain a blue ethernet cable from the session organiser. Go to your Control Panel and select Network Connections. Depending upon your operating system you will need to edit your existing connection, or you may be able to create a new connection.

Go to the TCP-IP settings for this connection. Select **Obtain IP address automatically**, and **Obtain DNS server address automatically**. You may need to restart your computer before you can obtain Internet access.

Proxy Settings:

Regardless of your method of connection, in your browser, it will be necessary to set the proxy settings to filter.vicone.net.au.
The port number of the proxy server is 8080
